**SCE Test Year 2003 General Rate Case (Update)  
Friday, June 21, 2002**

Members of CAL-SLA Executive Committee and Attorneys --

Last Thursday June 13, 2002, Dave and I attended the pre-hearing conference in Southern California Edison's (SCE) 2003 Test Year General Rate Case (GRC), Application 02-05-004. We formally intervened on behalf of CaL-SLA.

Administrative Law Judge Mark Wetzell and Assigned CPUC Commissioner Carl Wood will prepare a scoping memo identifying the issues to be heard in the GRC and set a schedule for the rate case. Like in prior GRC's, the 2003 GRC will be divided into two phases. Phase I will establish Edison's revenue requirement, and Phase II will design electric rates to recover the CPUC-authorized revenue requirement. CaL-SLA will be more active in Phase II and will recommend rates for street lighting and traffic control signals.

During Phase I, Cal-SLA will be analyzing SCE's capital and operation and maintenance costs for streetlight facilities.
